(ROSEMARY LANE, SOUTH OF THE RIVER, LANCASTER CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length on Rosemary Lane, South of the River, Lancaster from outside property number 1 for 10 meters in a Southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1900 hours until 0000 hours on Wednesday 22nd July 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to replace 2 manhole frames and cover works to be carried out by Sapphire Waste Water on behalf of United Utilities.
