(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over those lengths of
 - i. **Pilgrim Street, Nelson** from its junction with railway Street to its junction with Brunswick Street.
 - ii. **Rear 71 to 115 Sackville Street, Nelson** from its junction with Railway Street and its junction with Rear 184 to 224 Brunswick Street.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 1015 hours until 1700 hours on Friday 11th September 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the urgent carriageway repairs to be carried out.
