(REAR 66-114 NEW HALL STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Rear 66-114 New Hall Street, Burnley from the rear of property number to 78 for 20 metres in an Easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 17th August 2026 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 19th August 2026 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
New Hall Street- North Street- Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the disconnection of an old lead piper and replacing it with a new one works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
