Marital Status, 2011 Census of Population

Table 1 has the Lancashire marital status figures from the 2011 Census of Population that have been downloaded from the <u>Office for National Statistics</u> website.

In total 32.6% of adults in the Lancashire-14 area classified themselves as single. This was marginally less than the national average of 34.6%. Preston, with 40.9%, recorded the highest proportion of single residents in the county, whilst the rate for Fylde was much lower at 26.4%. In total 46.6% of residents aged 16 or over were classified as married at the national level, which was just below the Lancashire-14 rate of 46.9%. Six Lancashire authorities recorded married rates of above 50%, including Ribble Valley were the percentage was 54.6%. In contrast, the rate for Blackpool was just 39.0%.

Fylde and Wyre are localities noted to be popular with an older age group, and both recorded rates of above 9% for residents who were widowed or were a surviving partner from a civil partnership.

Blackpool, with 0.5%, had the highest rate of people in a registered same sex civil partnership. The same authority also had the highest divorce rate (13.1%) in Lancashire. In comparison, the rate for Preston was just 8.7%.
