

Highways Maintenance Capital Programme Update

2 of the 3 capital schemes, due for delivery in quarter 3 have either been completed or are progressing as planned and are detailed below.

Progress As Expected

Road Safety

- **Queens Terrace by Euston Hotel in Fleetwood (Wyreside)** – works have been completed to provide a refuge linking the promenade with the town centre.

Flood Risk Management and Drainage

- **Cart Gate Lane in Preesall (Wyreside)** – works to install a new drain and ditch have been completed which will reduce the risk of flooding from the school playing fields.

Progress Not As Expected

Flood Risk Management and Drainage

- **Ainspool in Churchtown (Garstang)** – designs for the scheme are currently being prepared with works anticipated to start during quarter 4 2015/2016. The proposed works may involve the installation of a new drainage section to alleviate flooding to the highway. The delay is due to the complexity of the works that are required.

Between April and December 2015/16, a total of 4,527 highway defects were identified by regular Highway Safety Inspections (HSI) or reported by the public in Wyre.

4,438 (98%) of these defects were repaired within 20 working days between April to December.
