Dwelling stock by tenure in Lancashire

Introduction

The figures used in this article have been downloaded from the Department for Communities and Local Government website (<u>Table 100</u>).

A dwelling is defined as a self contained unit of accommodation: when all the rooms (including the kitchen, bathroom and toilet) are behind a door which only that household can use.

Lancashire results

The 2017 results indicate a total dwelling stock of 670,820 for the Lancashire-14 area, of which, 87.3% was owner occupied or privately rented. This was above the England average of 82.6%, and is because Lancashire has much less accommodation in local authority ownership than the national average. Only Lancaster, West Lancashire and Blackpool had large numbers of dwellings within this category.

Blackpool, Fylde, Lancaster, Ribble Valley, South Ribble and Wyre had over 89.4% of their dwellings in the owner-occupied and privately rented sector.

Registered social landlords accounted for over 10% of dwellings in eight Lancashire local authorities. These included Preston and Blackburn with Darwen where this category accounted for 18% or more of dwellings. This meant that these two authorities had the lowest percentages in the Lancashire-14 area in the owner occupied and privately rented sector.

Private-sector data on rental levels in Lancashire

The Zoopla website is said to be a leading UK market resource for properties to sale or rent. The website has a <u>current values section</u> (go to browse property current values by area option) that contains the Lancashire results within the North West England option. By clicking on the Lancashire option, details are revealed for the average sale prices and rental levels for a large number of towns in the county. Please also see the <u>data page for Lancashire</u> that includes the current price breakdown by property type and the average property rental price.

Social housing

The <u>Homes and Communities Agency</u> (HCA) is the national housing and regeneration agency for England. The agency is also the regulator of social housing providers and works with local partners to create new affordable homes and thriving neighbourhoods.

The government publishes details of <u>current registered providers of social housing</u>. The list includes a selection of organisations that have an address within Lancashire-14. A number are sub-sections of larger groups, whilst others target particular age cohorts such as the elderly. The list includes the <u>Progress Housing Group</u> and Ribble Valley Homes, now part of <u>Onward Homes</u> <u>Limited</u>. Other organisations that do not have a Lancashire address will however have social housing sites in the county, or incorporate sub-groups in Lancashire that are independently listed as providers. For instance, the <u>Together Housing Group</u> has a Halifax address but includes Housing Pendle, Twin Valley Homes (Blackburn with Darwen) and Green Vale Homes (Rossendale).

The Regenda Group website states that the organisation has around <u>3,500 properties in</u> <u>Lancashire</u>. The find a home to rent page highlights the fact that the group has a substantial <u>presence in Wyre district</u>.
