This Notice is published on the County Council's website and served by email on those persons who have requested notification under Regulation 21 of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 and served on other persons required to be so notified.

An application has been made to the Registration Authority, the Lancashire County Council of County Hall, Preston, Lancashire, PR1 8XJ ('the Registration Authority) by John Douglas James Welbank and Sylvia Margaret Welbank ('the Applicant') under Regulation 43 of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 ('the Regulations').

The application seeks to amend the relevant entry in the rights section of CL23 to record a declaration of the Applicant's entitlement to exercise part of the right attached to Ireby Green, Ireby, Lancashire. The right referred to is a right to graze 45 sheep gaits over that part of the land known as Ireby Fell, in the Parish of Ireby. For the declaration to be made the Registration Authority will need to be satisfied that the supporting documents with the application have the effect of evidencing that the part of the land to which the right is attached is owned by the Applicant. If the Registration Authority is satisfied that the evidence is sufficient it will accept the application and record the change of how the right is held. The application and supporting documentation may be inspected during the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm at Office of the Director of Governance, Finance and Public Services, Christ Church Precinct, County Hall, Preston, PR1 8XJ.

Any representations that are taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the Applicants for comment in accordance with Regulation 25 and may be disclosed to other interested parties. If the application is referred to the Planning Inspectorate for determination in accordance with Regulation 26 of the Regulations any representations will be sent to the Planning Inspectorate.
