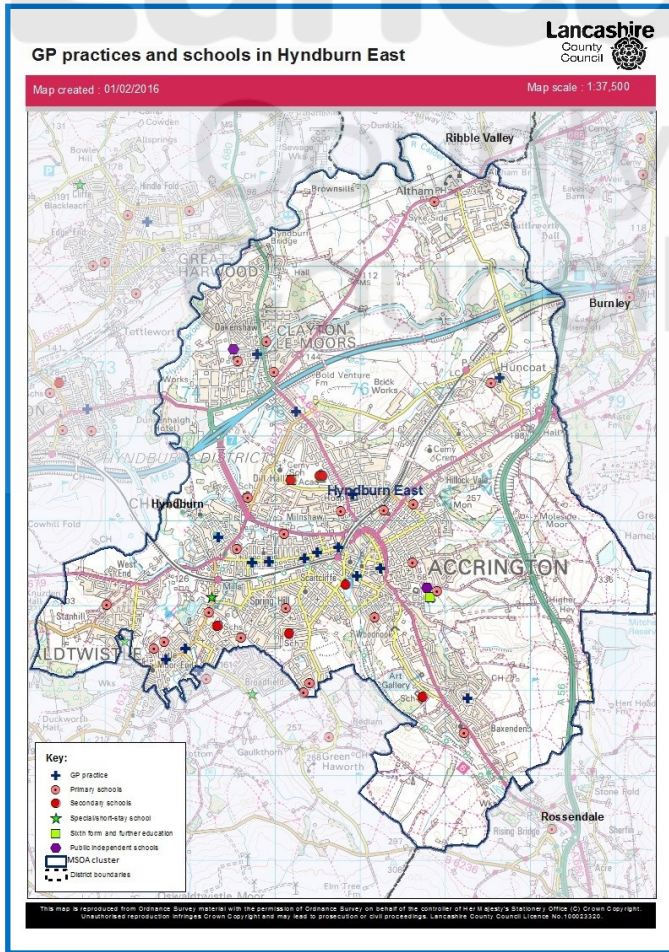


## Lancashire County Council Children & Young People's Public Health —Child Health Profiles 2017

Public Health, assisted by Business Intelligence within Lancashire County Council have created 34 middle level (MSOA\* cluster) Child Health Profiles (CHPs). This is because the CHPs on the Public Health England website are only at upper tier level. This does not show the outcome data at sub-district level but just an overview of children and young people's health across the whole of County. These lower level profiles highlight where children's health needs are the greatest and opportunities to reduce inequalities are greatest.



### Hyndburn East

There are 22 primary schools in Hyndburn East, 6 secondary schools, 2 independent schools, 1 special school and 2 further education colleges.

There are 15 GP practices.

Hyndburn East has a number of indicators that are ranked as the worst in the County (1st). These include the proportion of live births to mums <20 years and the number of children on a child protection order or being looked after. There is also a high rate of children aged 0-4 needing emergency hospitalisation.

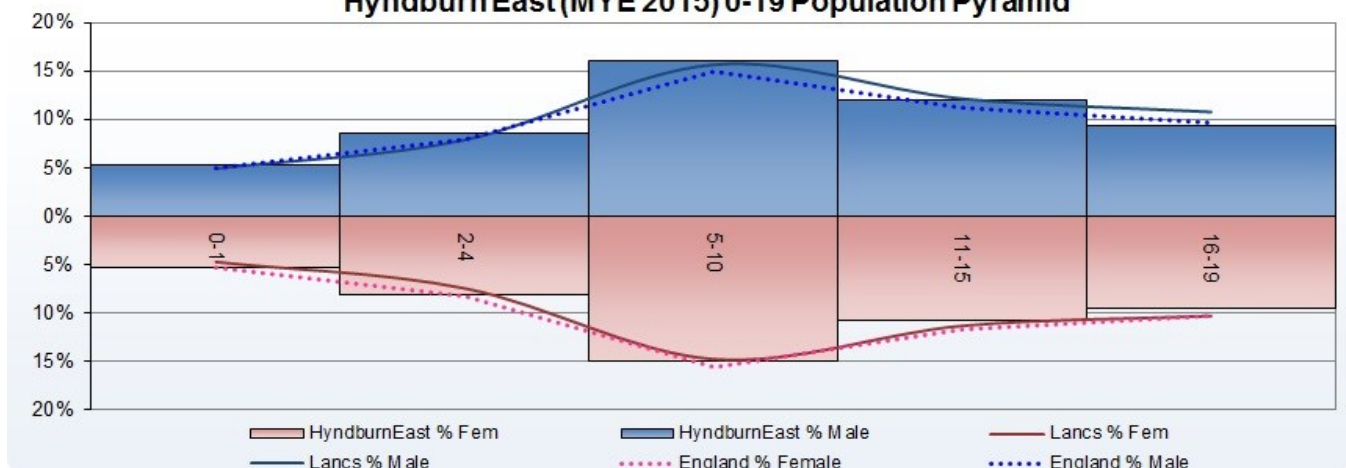
The 'best' indicator is ranked 12 of the 34 CHPs where 34 = best and this is the rate of children involved in a road traffic accident with 2.75 deaths or serious injuries per 1000 children living here.

Less than half of children achieve key stage 2 (6th) or 4 education (8th).

62% of 5 year olds achieved a good level of development at the end of reception (5th) and 5% of young people are not in education employment

Indicators are ranked according to their position within the 34 MSOA clusters created throughout Lancashire. The colour ramp indicates in which quintile the value is located. The top seven being **red** (worst 5th), the next seven being **orange** (2nd worst 5th) the mid 6 being **yellow** (middle 5th) the next to best seven being **blue** (2nd best fifth) and the lowest seven being **green** (best 5th)
