(LIME ROAD, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2018

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed through the junction of Lime Road, Accrington with Marlborough Road.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours until 1530 hours on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018 or until completion of the works within this period.
3. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
  - a) Northbound traffic travelling to south of the closure and vice versa: Marlborough Road – Ribblesdale Avenue – A680 Whalley Road – B6237 Queens Road – Marlborough Road.
  - b) Eastbound traffic travelling to north of the closure and vice versa: Lime Road – Clifton Avenue – B6237 Queens Road – Marlborough Road.
  - c) Eastbound traffic travelling to south of the closure and vice versa: Lime Road – Clifton Avenue – Moss Hall Road – Marlborough Road.
  - d) Westbound traffic travelling to north of the closure and vice versa: Lime Road – Haywood Road – B6237 Queens Road – Marlborough Road.
  - e) Westbound traffic travelling to south of the closure and vice versa: Lime Road – Haywood Road – Moss Hall Road – Marlborough Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow utility works to be carried out.
