

APPENDIX 3

DRESS CODE

The Authority is committed to encouraging the professional image of the Drivers operating under its Contracts for Route Instructions and it considers that Drivers should conform to a minimum standard of dress, as set out below, in order to raise and maintain the positive profile of the Authority and its Services.

Acceptable standards of dress within this code

Tops

- Shirts, blouses, T-shirts or sweat tops should cover the shoulders and be capable of being worn inside trousers or shorts.
- Shirts or blouses can be worn with a tie or open-necked.

Trousers/shorts/skirts

- Trousers may be either full length or shorts if tailored.
- Sport shorts should not be worn.
- Short skirts should not be worn.
- Smart jeans type trousers permitted.

Footwear

- Enclosed robust flat shoe.
- Footwear should fit around the heel of feet.

Examples of unacceptable standards of dress within this code

- Bare chests.
- Unclean or damaged clothing or footwear.
- Clothing with offensive words, logos or graphics.
- Clothing with studs or sharp edges.
- Beach type footwear (e.g. flip flops, crocs and mules).
- Baseball caps or "hoodies".
- Tracksuits or shellsuits.
- High heels.
- Skirts/dresses above the knee.
