
## MAIN INFRASTRUCTURE ELEMENTS

The construction of the Preston Western Distributor will include the construction of four major bridges (including two viaducts) and three underpasses.

## Bridges

- Becconsall Bridge (M55 Junction 2) a single span 45 metre long weathering steel bridge over the motorway.
- Bartle Lane Bridge a single span 30 metre long concrete beam bridge with brick faced abutments.

## Viaducts

- Lea Viaduct a 5 span 233 metre long weathering steel viaduct taking the road and the Blackpool to Preston railway line over the Lancaster Canal.
- Savick Brook Viaduct a 6 span 278 metre long weathering steel viaduct taking the road over the Ribble Link Navigation, the Guild Wheel and the valley in which it passes.

## Underpasses

- Darkinson Underpass a 3.75 metre x 5.8 metre wide underpass suitable for cyclists, pedestrians and horses.
- Bartle Underpass a 4 metre x 4 metre wide underpass with a public footpath allowing wildlife, farm vehicles and cyclists and pedestrians to pass under the new road.
- Earls Farm Cattle Creep will be a 3 metre x 3 metre wide underpass to enable the farm to access all its land.
