

MAIN INFRASTRUCTURE ELEMENTS

The construction of the Preston Western Distributor will include the construction of four major bridges (including two viaducts) and three underpasses.

Bridges

- **Beaconsall Bridge** (M55 Junction 2) - a single span 45 metre long weathering steel bridge over the motorway.
- **Bartle Lane Bridge** - a single span 30 metre long concrete beam bridge with brick faced abutments.

Viaducts

- **Lea Viaduct** - a 5 span 233 metre long weathering steel viaduct taking the road and the Blackpool to Preston railway line over the Lancaster Canal.
- **Savick Brook Viaduct** - a 6 span 278 metre long weathering steel viaduct taking the road over the Ribble Link Navigation, the Guild Wheel and the valley in which it passes.

Underpasses

- **Darkinson Underpass** - a 3.75 metre x 5.8 metre wide underpass suitable for cyclists, pedestrians and horses.
- **Bartle Underpass** - a 4 metre x 4 metre wide underpass with a public footpath allowing wildlife, farm vehicles and cyclists and pedestrians to pass under the new road.
- **Earls Farm Cattle Creep** will be a 3 metre x 3 metre wide underpass to enable the farm to access all its land.
