

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BARTLE LANE, LOWER BARTLE AND DARKINSON LANE, LEA, PRESTON CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the City of Preston;
 - i. Bartle Lane, Lower Bartle from its junction with Lea Lane to a point 238m north-east of its junction with Lea Lane.
 - ii. Darkinson Lane, Lea from a point 100m north-east of its junction with Darkinson Lane to a point 450m north-east of its junction with Darkinson Lane.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative on the following dates or until completion of the works within the periods specified;
 - i. Bartle Lane, Lower Bartle from Wednesday 27th May 2020 at 0600 hours until Thursday 30th June 2022 at 1300 hours.
 - ii. Darkinson Lane, Lea from Friday 24th April 2020 at 0600 hours until Friday 31st March 2023 at 1300 hours.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Diversion 1 (Bartle Lane)

Bartle Lane – Sandy Lane – Hoyles Lane – Sidgreaves Lane – Lea Lane and vice versa.

Diversion 2 (Bartle Lane)

Darkinson Lane – Sidgreaves Lane – Lea Lane – Darkinson Lane and vice versa.

5. An alternative route for pedestrians affected by the closure will be locally signed.
6. Nothing in this order shall apply so as to prohibit access to prevent pedestrian access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary allow construction works in relation to the Preston Western Distributor to be carried out.
