## How is coronavirus affecting people in Lancashire?

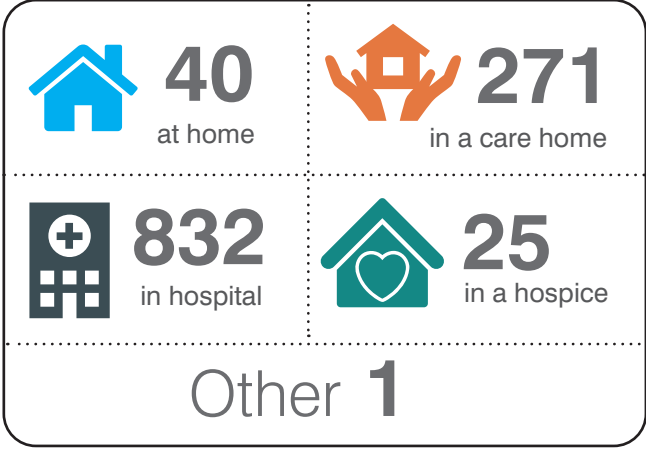

It also shows how Lancashire compares to other areas of the country.

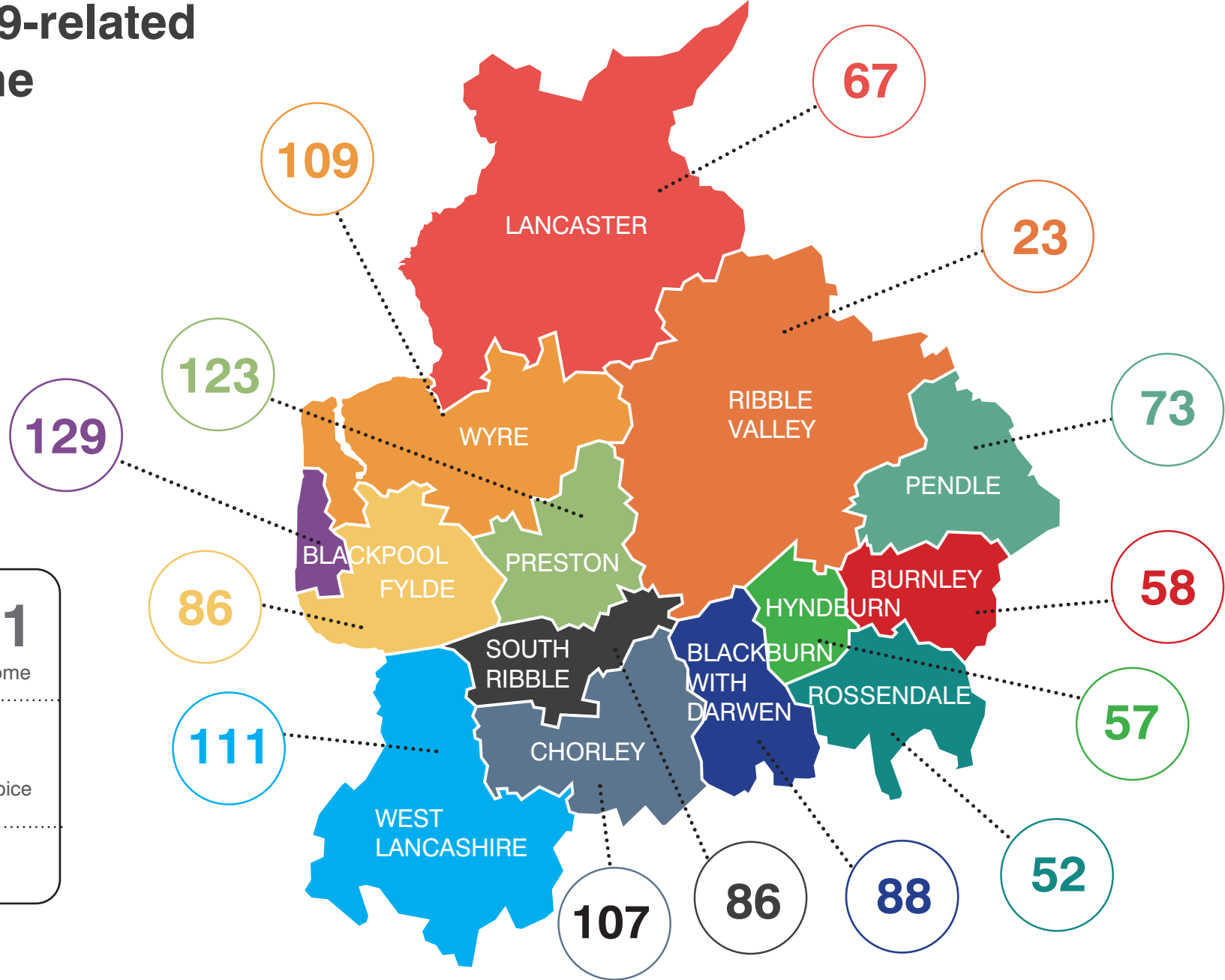


# Registered Covid-19-related deaths up to 20 June

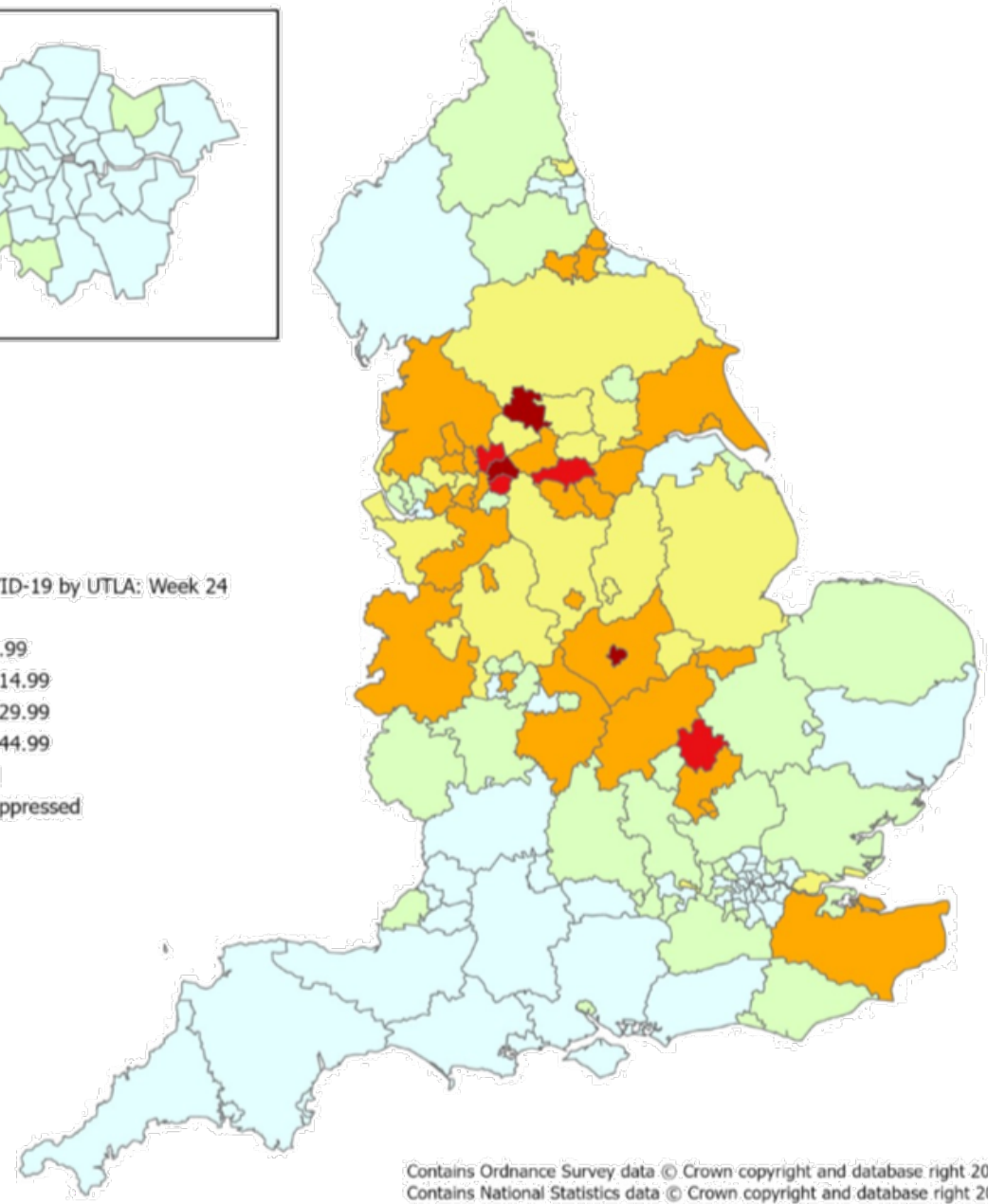
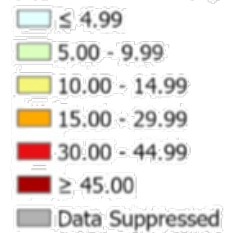

# Weekly rate of Covid-19 cases per 100,000 population (Week ending 14th June).

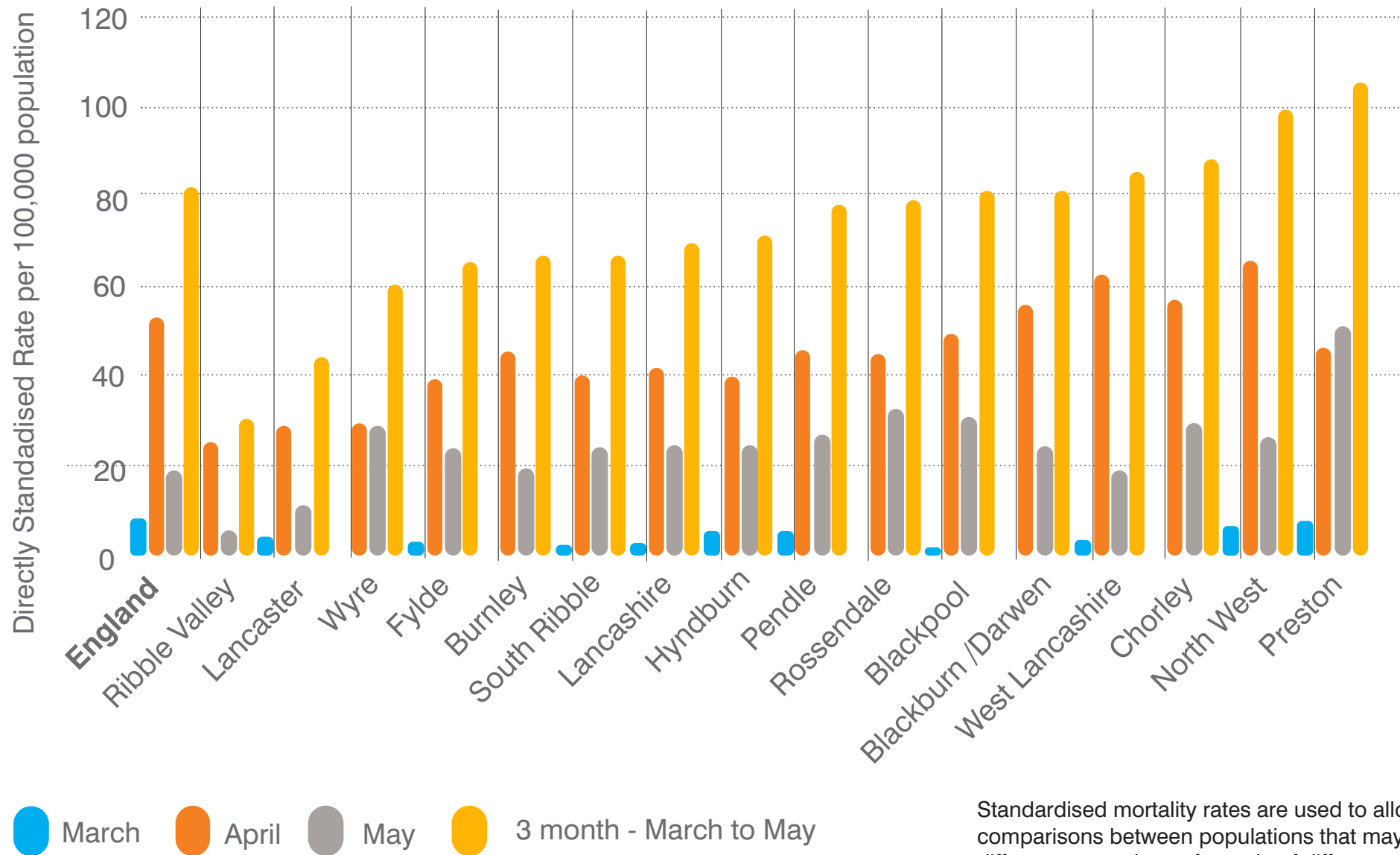


Rate of COVID-19 by UTLA: Week 24

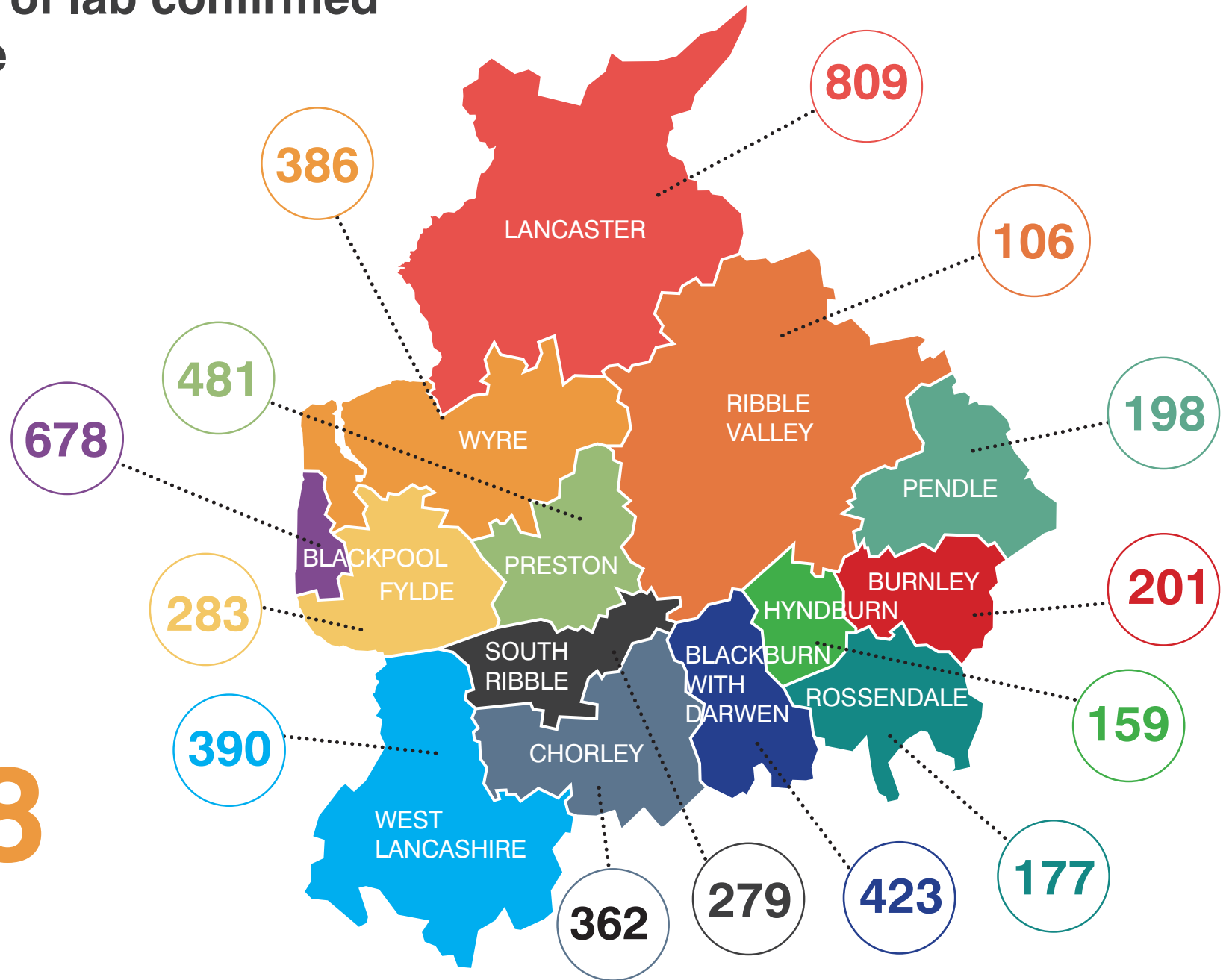
