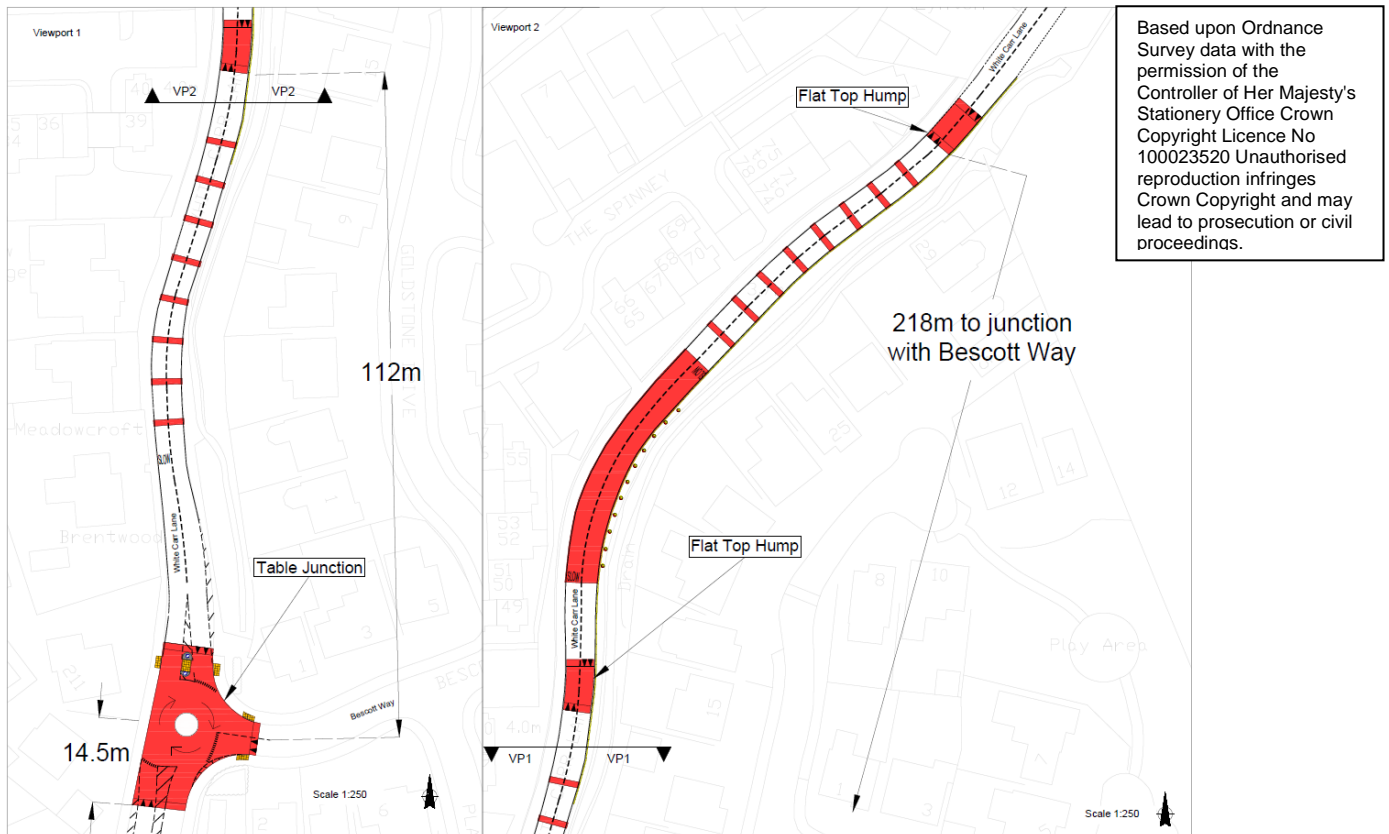


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(WHITE CARR LANE, THORNTON CLEVELEYS, WYRE
BOROUGH) (ROAD HUMPS)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to:

1. Introduce a junction table in White Carr Lane, Thornton Cleveleys, from approximately 14.5 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Bescott Way, for a distance of 28 metres in a northerly direction.
The junction table will have a maximum height not exceeding 100 millimetres.
2. Introduce road humps in the following lengths of road:
 - a) White Carr Lane, Thornton Cleveleys, from approximately 112 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Bescott Way, for a distance of 9 metres in a northerly direction.
 - b) White Carr Lane, Thornton Cleveleys, from approximately 218 metres north east of its junction with the centreline of Bescott Way, for a distance of 9 metres in a north easterly direction.
The road humps will have a maximum height not exceeding 100 millimetres.



Statement of Reasons

The proposed road humps aim to reduce traffic speeds on White Carr Lane and improve safety for motorised users, cyclists and pedestrians.
