Lancashire Universal 2 Year Review Integrated Pathway

Health Visitor Team (HV)

At the 9-12 month review Health Visitor/Family Health Practitioner to place the consent to share sheet information in the Red Book and Parents encouraged to share with EES. EES to ask parents to see the Red Book.

Early Education Setting

(EES) gains consent to share and places this in the Red Book, keeping a copy for setting records.

HV Team - If a child has identified risk factors e.g. CIN and CP plans health visiting team to consider if it is appropriate to hold a review in a setting with other professionals.

EES - A copy of the progress check at 2 to be inserted into the Red Book. EES to contact the Health visiting team with any developmental concerns ahead of the 2year-2 1/2 year developmental assessment. (If the child begins nursery after the age of 2 and before age 3 this should still take place as soon as possible).

Healthy Family Practitioner to liaise with named Nursery every term.

Health Visiting Team (HV) - Consent to share outcomes/actions of the assessment with EES discussed with parent /carer.

EES consent to share information declined and documented

- 1. Consider if a referral to Children's Social Care is required.
- 2. Consider how the settings own staff team can meet the needs of the child in the setting.
- 3. Consider how the settings own staff team can influence the home learning environment.
- 4. Seek professional advice as appropriate to up skill the settings own staff team (without identifying specific children).
- 5. Continue liaising with parents/carers.

Pathway for all Children - Health and Development Check- 2-2 ½ year assessment completed.

Consent declined

- when consent to share is declined always document this electronically in Child Health record. Any concerns normal procedures to be followed as per internal Standard Operating Procedure).
