

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, FYLDE BOROUGH AREA) (REVOCATION AND
INTRODUCTION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 45 and 46 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Fylde Borough Area) (Revocation and Introduction of Parking Places) Order 2015" in full.
2. Introduce permit holders eligible properties:
