

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Wyre Coastal Parking Restrictions

Dock Street, Fleetwood – Mount Road, Fleetwood – Queens Terrace, Fleetwood – The Esplanade, Fleetwood

Bispham Road, Thornton-Cleveleys - Coronation Road, Thornton-Cleveleys – Ellerbeck Road, Thornton-Cleveleys - Kingsway, Thornton-Cleveleys – North Promenade, Thornton-Cleveleys – Rossall Promenade, Thornton-Cleveleys – South Promenade, Thornton-Cleveleys – Victoria Road West, Thornton-Cleveleys

Ashton Avenue, Knott-end-on-sea - Bourne May Road, Knott-end-on-sea – Esplanade, Knott-end-on-sea – Quail Holme Road, Knott-end-on-sea – Salisbury Avenue, Knott-end-on-Sea

"The purpose of this proposed order is to encourage visitor coaches to the area by introducing dedicated Bus drop off/pick-up bays and lay-over bays are also proposed to accommodate coach parking along with measures to prevent anti-social overnight parking and time limit the parking bays on Queens Terrace to allow for a turnover of parking spaces for anyone wishing to visit the museum and markets, whilst still maintaining car parking for residents and visitors to the area.

This order further proposes to introduce additional No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on Mount Road, Fleetwood and Bispham Road, Thornton-Cleveleys in areas where parked vehicles are causing an obstruction to traffic and pedestrians thereby increasing safety for users of the highway whilst clarifying, simplifying and tidying up a selection of traffic orders that have been identified in these areas.

The orders are to improve the safety of all highway users (including pedestrians) whilst providing parking amenities where necessary."

Reasons under Sect 1 RTRA 1984

- (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
