What are we doing?

A Community Alcohol Partnership (CAP) has been set up in the Skelmersdale area to tackle underage drinking. The CAP brings together organisations including the council, the police, schools, alcohol services and local retailers to reduce the crime, anti-social behaviour and harm caused by underage drinking.

Some of the work we are doing includes:

- Training and supporting local retailers.
- Carrying out police patrols and confiscating alcohol from young people
- Providing help and information for young people, parents and the community
- Targeting and prosecuting adults who supply alcohol to young people
