

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(NORTH PROMENADE, THORNTON CLEVELEYS, WYRE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice **AND FURTHER the County Council is satisfied that the aforementioned works will take in excess of 18 months to execute.**

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of North Promenade, Thornton Cleveleys from North Promenade Car Park to 47 North Promenade.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative as follows:
 - i. A continuous closure from 0800 hours on Monday 19th April 2021 until 1800 hours on Monday 31st May 2021.
 - ii. A daily closure **Monday to Friday** from 0800 hours to 1800 hours on Tuesday 1st June 2021 until Saturday 30th November 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Carr Gate – Thornton Gate

Beach Road – Rossall Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the construction of coastal defence scheme to be carried out on behalf of Wyre Borough Council.
