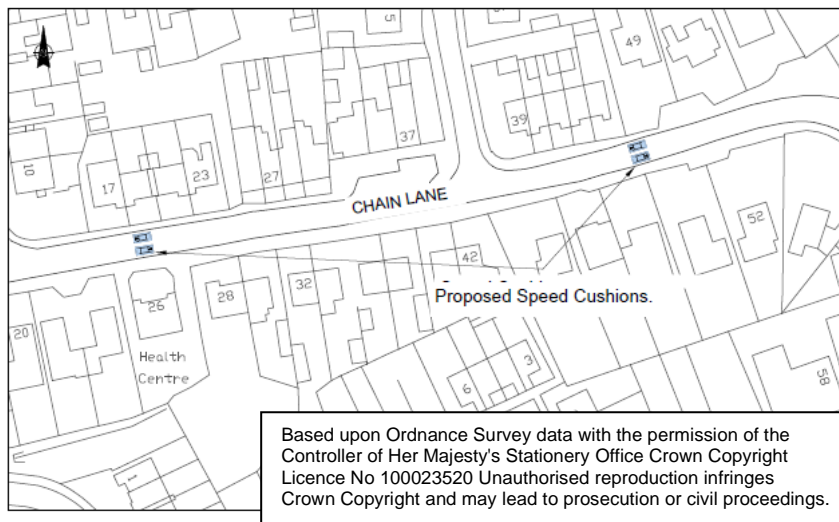
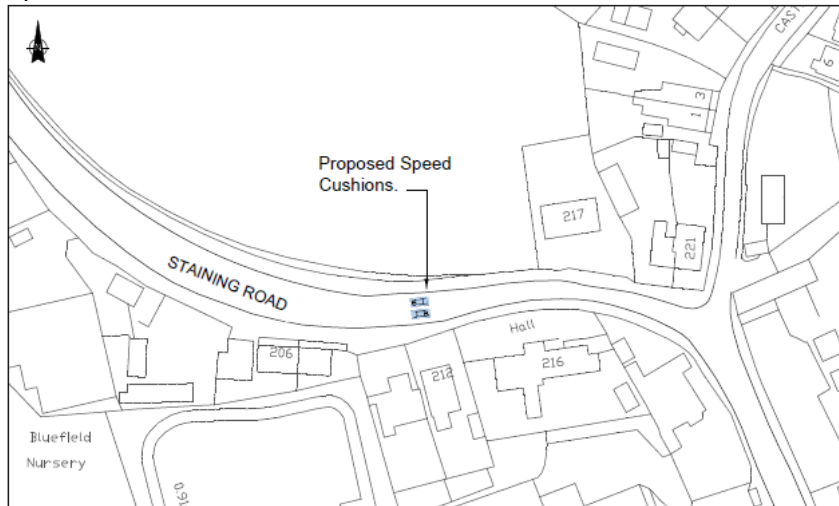


**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(CHAIN LANE, AND STAINING ROAD, STAINING, FYLDE**  
**BOROUGH) (ROAD HUMPS)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce speed cushions in the following locations:

1. Staining Road, Staining, from a point 70 metres west of the junction of Castle Lane for a distance of 3.5 metres in a westerly direction.
2. Chain Lane, Staining, from a point 33 metres north east from the centre line of Meadow Park for a distance of 3.5 metres in a north easterly direction.
3. Chain Lane, Staining, from a point 37 metres north east from the centre line of Bleasdale Avenue for a distance of 3.5 metres in a north easterly direction.

The maximum height of the speed cushions will be 75mm.



**Statement of Reasons**

Numerous accidents have occurred on Chain Lane and Staining Road due to vehicles travelling at excessive speeds. Therefore, in order to try and reduce the average speed of vehicles it is proposed to introduce a traffic calming scheme and install a number of speed cushions.
