THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY PUBLIC FOOTPATH FROM BANKS ROAD TO STATION ROAD, NORTH MEOLS, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH (DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION) ORDER 2014

The above Order, made on the 18th December 2014, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by adding a public footpath from Banks Road (Point A on the Order plan) (SD 3796 2086) adjacent from 100 Banks Road running a south south easterly direction along the east side of a field boundary for approximately 90 metres on a 1.5 metre wide undefined route to cross a field boundary (Point C) and then continuing in a generally south easterly direction parallel to The Sluice for approximately 520 metres as a 3 metre wide path to the junction with Station Road (Point I) (SD 3826 2033), for a total distance of approximately 610 metres and shown on the Order plan.

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2014

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lancashire County Council intend to make an Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit any motor vehicle and cycles from proceeding over that stretch of Hill House Fold Lane from its junction with Courage Lane to its junction with Robin Hood Lane, Wrightington, West Lancashire Borough.

An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via Moss Lane - A5209 Hill Lane - Robin Hood Lane and vice versa.

The temporary closure is necessary to allow highway drainage works to be carried out.

The prohibition will be in operation daily between 0800 hours and 1600 hours on Monday 2nd February 2015 until Wednesday 4th February, or until completion of the works within the period.

PUBLIC FOOTPATHS AT BANKS ENCLOSED MARSH, NORTH MEOLS, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH (DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION) ORDER 2014

The above Order made on the 18th December 2014, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the area, by adding 3 public footpaths as described below:

1 A 3 metre wide public footpath from the junction of Georges Lane and public footpaths 48 & 49 North Meols (Point A on the Order plan) (SD 3885 2188) running in a north westerly direction to Point D ending at the junction with public footpaths 38 & 39 North Meols (SD 3852 2236), for a total distance of approximately 570 metres

2 A 3 metre wide public footpath from the junction of Charleys Lane and public footpaths 47 & 48 North Meols (Point F) (SD 3835 2156) running in a north westerly direction to Point I (SD 3803 2201) for a total distance of approximately 370 metres

3 A 3 metre wide public footpath starting from the junction with public footpaths 47 North Meols (Point J) (SD 3796 2119) running in a northerly direction to Point K, the path then continues in a generally south westerly direction and ends at Point O on the Order plan at its junction with public footpaths 40 North Meols (SD 3730 2086) for a total distance of approximately 770 metres

4 A 3 metre wide public footpath starting from the junction of the farm track at Point K on the Order plan (SD 3796 2121) continuing in a north westerly direction to Point R (SD 3760 2171) for a total distance of approximately 635 metres

5 A 1.5 metre wide public footpath starting at the junction with public footpaths 48 North Meols, close to Cross Barn Cottage, (Point S on the Order plan) (SD 3856 2176), continuing in a north westerly direction to Point V (SD 3827 2218), for a total distance of approximately 520 metres
