(FOX STREET AND FLEET STREET, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice **AND FURTHER** the County Council are satisfied that these works will take in excess of 18 months to execute.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the city of Preston;
 - i. Fox Street, Preston from a point 37 metres north of its junction with St Wilfrid Street to its end.
 - ii. Fleet Street, Preston from its junction with Corporation Street for a distance of 90 metres in a north easterly direction.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 28th June 2021 until 1630 hours on Thursday 5th January 2023 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not available

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow construction works to be carried out.
