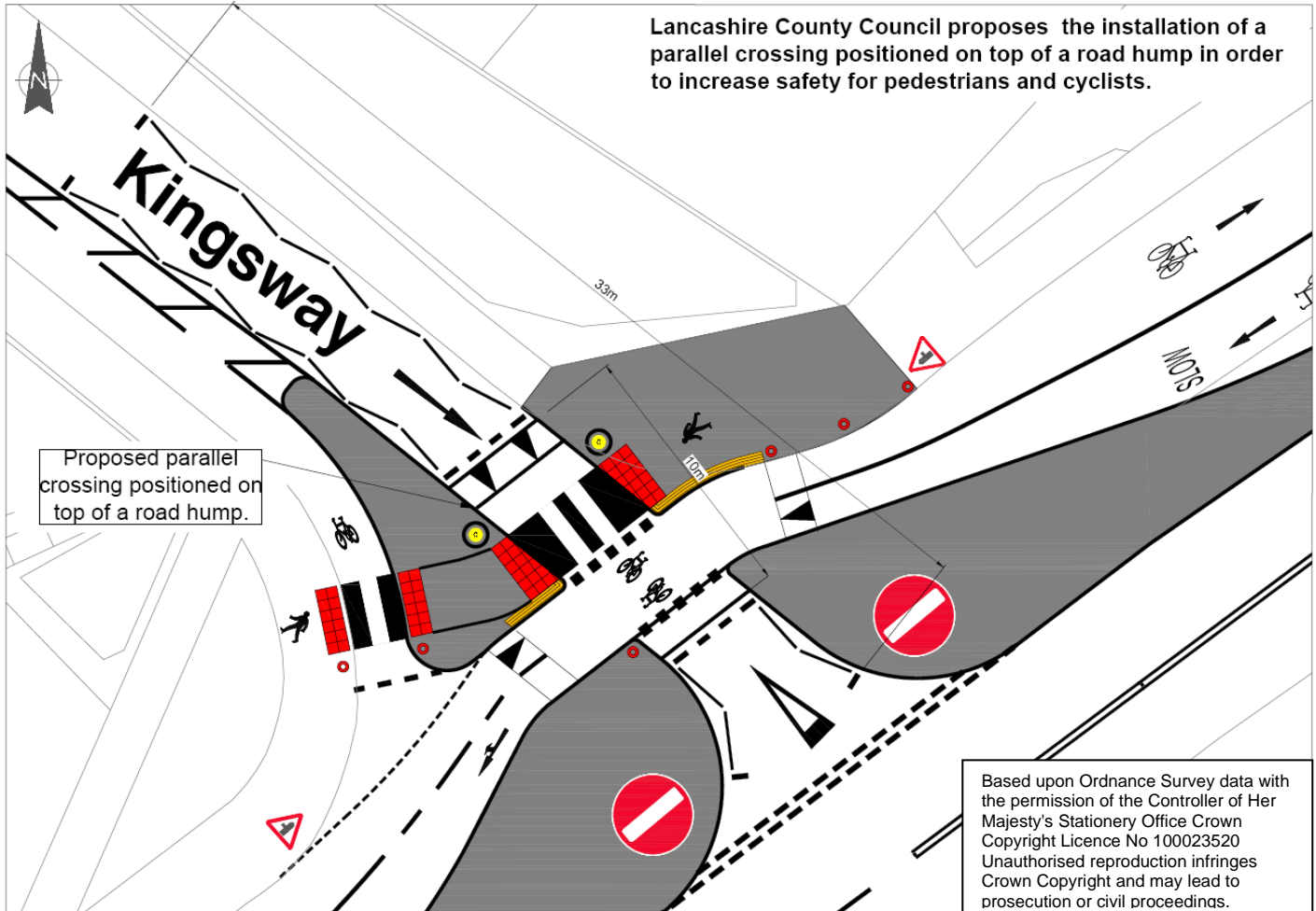


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(KINGSWAY, PENWORTHAM, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (ROAD
HUMP AND PARALLEL CROSSING)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose the following.

1. That in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a road hump in Kingsway, Penwortham, from a point 7.5 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Liverpool Road, for a distance of 10 metres in a north westerly direction. The road hump will have a maximum height of 100 millimetres.
2. That in accordance with Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce the following parallel crossing in Kingsway, Penwortham, from a point approximately 2.5 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Liverpool Road, for a distance of 33 metres on a north westerly direction.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this proposal is to increase the safety of cyclists using the proposed two-way segregated cycle path on Liverpool Road.

The introduction of one-way restrictions in addition to the parallel crossing positioned on top of a road hump will reduce traffic volume on Kingsway with consequent safety improvements to pedestrians, cyclists and other vulnerable users on adjacent cycle lanes and footpaths and will improve and encourage sustainable transport in and between local residential, employment and tourism areas.
