

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CLIFTON DRIVE NORTH, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH)
(REVOCATION, PROHIBITION OF WAITING, POLICE VEHICLE PARKING
PLACE AND RED ROUTE) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Fylde Area) (On Street Parking Places, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Consolidation Order 2009" insofar as it relates to:
 - a) Items (70)a)(i), (70)a)(ii), (70)b)(ii), (70)b)(vi), (70)c)(ii), (70)c)(iv) and (70)d) of Schedule 10.01;
 - b) Item (1) of Schedule 11.104;
 - c) Schedule 11.109.
2. Introduce a red route, the effect of which is to prohibit the stopping of vehicles in the main carriageway, footway and verge, in Clifton Drive North, Lytham St Annes, both sides, from its junction with Squire's Gate Lane for a distance of approximately 1,922 metres in a southerly direction, to a point 17 metres south of its junction with the Centreline of Highbury Road West
3. Introduce a police parking place in Clifton Drive North, Lytham St Annes, the west side, from a point 95 metres south of its junction with the Centreline of Addison Way for a distance of 9.5 metres in a general southerly direction.
As a consequence of this proposal the existing police bay would be removed from Clifton Drive North, Lytham St Annes, from a point 114 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Addison Way for a distance of 9.5 metres in a southerly direction
4. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Clifton Drive North, Lytham St Annes, the east side, from a point 17 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Highbury Road West in a southerly direction to a point 59 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Norwood Road;
 - b) Clifton Drive North, Lytham St Annes, the west side, from a point 17 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Highbury Road West in a southerly direction to its junction with the centreline of Todmorden Road.
