
NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LONGFIELD AVENUE, COPPULL,
CHORLEY BOROUGH) (ROAD HUMP)



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a road hump in Longfield Avenue, Coppull, from a point 71.5 metres west of its junction with the centreline of The Heys, for a distance of 4.5 metres in a westerly direction. The road hump will have a maximum height of 75 millimetres.



Statement of Reasons

As part of the public realm improvements to protect and promote pedestrian movements when accessing the public play area situated to the south of Longfield Avenue the new traffic calming feature is proposed to support the existing 20mph speed limit.
