

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(STATION ROAD, BAMBER BRIDGE, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)
(REVOCAION, LIMITED WAITING, PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND
PROHIBITION OF LOADING) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to:

1. Revoke the following;
 - a) The "Lancashire County Council (Station Road Area, Bamber Bridge, South Ribble Borough) (Revocation, Prohibition of Waiting, Limited Waiting and Prohibition of Loading) Order 2019" insofar as it relates to:
 - i. Item k) of Schedule 2;
 - ii. Item q) of Schedule 3;
 - iii. Item c) of Schedule 4.
 - b) "The Borough of South Ribble (Principal Road A6 – Station Road. Bamber Bridge and Chorley Road, Part of Walton-le-Dale) (Bus Stops, Clearway and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1979" insofar as it relates to the bus stop clearway from 7am to 9am, on A6 Station Road/Chorley Road, both sides, from its junction with Havelock Road to a point approximately 53 metres north west of its junction with Renshaw Drive.
2. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in Station Road, Bamber Bridge, the north east side, from its junction with the Centreline of Hodson Street for a distance of 17 metres in a south easterly direction.
3. Introduce a prohibition of loading/unloading in Station Road, Bamber Bridge, the north east side, from its junction with the Centreline of Hodson Street for a distance of 17 metres in a south easterly direction.
4. Introduce a limited waiting parking place for 30 minutes, with no return within 1 hour, Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm, in Station Road, Bamber Bridge, the north east side, from a point 17 metres south east of its junction with the Centreline of Hodson Street to a point 18.5 metres north west of its junction with the Centreline of Collins Road.
