WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 – PART III THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY PUBLIC FOOTPATH FROM BANKS ROAD TO STATION ROAD, NORTH MEOLS, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH (DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION) ORDER 2014

The above Order was made by Lancashire County Council (the "County Council") on 18th December 2014. Objections to the Order have been received and the County Council has not been able to secure the withdrawal of the objections. I am therefore referring the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for formal determination. To that end I enclose a completed Checklist for Order Making Authorities together with an indexed bundle of the required documents. The two copies of the Order have been sent to the above address by recorded mail.

It is confirmed that there are no statutory undertakers affected by the Order.

In this particular case, the County Council supports the confirmation of the Order (regardless of the process adopted by the Secretary of State in determining the outcome) and is content for the Secretary of State to make a decision by way of written representations.

If it is decided that a hearing or public inquiry is required, there are several dates over the next eleven months where the officers involved in the matter are not available and so we should be most grateful if these were avoided when listing a date for the hearing/public inquiry. The dates to be avoided (if possible) are as follows:

- 22nd Oct 5th Nov 2021
- 20th 31st Dec 2021
- 14th 24th February 2022
- 4th 15th April 2022
- 28th May 7th June 2022
- 20th July 23rd August 2022
