Terms and Conditions

1. This competition is free to enter.
2. The competition is open to all Lancashire libraries members (membership is free and you can join at any Lancashire library or online at our [Join the library](#) page ).
3. The competition will be open to entries from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021, until Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021.
4. Competition entry forms can be collected from your local Lancashire library branch. Or downloaded from [Your library at home](#) page.
5. You can also enter the competition by tweeting a review of a crime novel to @lancspublib using the hashtag #LancsCrimeCapers or by posting a message as a reply to the competition post on Lancashire Libraries Facebook page @lancslibraries. If you submit your entry via social media, you may be contacted via direct message to obtain library card number.
6. To submit a competition entry, completed forms can be returned to an open Lancashire Library branch, or emailed to [readingandlearningdevelopmentteam@lancashire.gov.uk](mailto:readingandlearningdevelopmentteam@lancashire.gov.uk)
7. Prizes will be awarded to one entry in each library, selected at random from all of the entries received from library members over the age of 18.
8. The prize is a copy of "Wish You Were Dead" by Peter James. There will be one copy available for each Lancashire Library branch.
9. The competition is open to anyone over the age of 18 (as of 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021), and there is no limit of number of entries per person.
10. Competition entries must include a note of your name and Lancashire Library card number (found on the back of your library card, starting 20118).
11. Any entry to the competition or extracts from it may be used (anonymously) on our website or on social media.
12. The winner will be notified by Friday 19<sup>th</sup> November by library staff using the nominated contact methods on their library account. At this point we will discuss the collection or delivery arrangements for the prize.
