Business Intelligence colleagues are developing a process to collect the required data and produce a dashboard for presentation to the Steering Group, this will provide assurance of the outcomes/ impact from the pilot.



Seyworking Function Training

On 23rd November, two teams within Lancashire & South Cumbria NHS Foundation Trust will be testing the first training session from the Keyworking pilot as part of our commitment to provide training to strategic leaders, commissioners and front line colleagues.

At the end of November and beginning of December, testing will be available as virtual courses.
