BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any of the following:
  - i. Motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Bankhouse Street, Burnley from its junction with Curzon Street to its end.
  - ii. Cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of footway on Curzon Street (west side footway) from its junction with Bankhouse Street to its junction with Parker Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022 until 1700 hours on 31<sup>st</sup> May 2023 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is not available. Pedestrians and cyclists will be diverted to the opposite footway.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Burnley town centre development works to be carried out.
