**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 119A
RAIL CROSSING DIVERSION ORDER
DIVERSION OF AN UNRECORDED PUBLIC FOOTPATH THAT LINKS FOOTPATH
POULTON-LE-FYLDE 4 WITH HOLTS LANE, WYRE BOROUGH**

The above Order was made by Lancashire County Council on 29th October 2019. Objections to the Order have been received and the county council has not been able to secure the withdrawal of the objection. I am therefore, referring the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for formal determination.

In this particular case, the County Council will not be supporting the Order and is taking a neutral stance. The applicant, Network Rail will be presenting the case with regard to confirming the Order.

It is confirmed that if the Order is confirmed Lancashire County Council shall see that notices are duly published and served or, if the Order is not confirmed, that notices will be duly served.

Ordinarily, documentation pertaining to this Order is held on deposit for public inspection at County Hall, Fishergate, Preston, PR1 8XJ.
