

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(FUTURES PARK, BACUP, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH) (ROAD HUMP**  
**AND ZEBRA CROSSING)**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose the following.

1. That in accordance with Section 90A of the **Highways Act 1980**, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce a road hump in Futures Park, Bacup, from a point 42.3 metres south east of its junction with Newchurch Road for a distance of 6 metres in a southerly direction and at a maximum height of 100mm.
2. That in accordance with Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, Lancashire County Council propose to introduce the following zebra crossing in Futures Park, Bacup, from a point 24.9 metres south east of its junction with Newchurch Road, for a distance of 40.8 metres in a southerly direction.
