

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (RED LEES ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (RESTRICTED ROAD AND 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2003

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Restricted Road

The length of Red Lees Road at Burnley, from a point 72 metres south east of the centreline of Hill Crest Avenue, for a distance of 150 metres in a south easterly direction shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.

2. 50mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour along the length of Red Lees Road at Burnley, from a point 222 metres south east of the centreline of Hill Crest Avenue, to a point 97 metres north west of the centreline of The Long Causeway.

3. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Red Lees Road, Burnley, Burnley Borough) (Restricted Road and 50mph Speed limit) Order 2003 " and shall come into force on the 18th January, 2003.
