(FORTY ACRE LANE, LONGRIDGE, RIBBLE VALLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Forty Acre Lane, Longridge, from the junction of Higher Road to the junction of the service road for Dilworth Upper Reservoir.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The Order will be in force daily between 0600 hours and 2000 hours on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022 to 17<sup>th</sup> August 2022 or until completion of the works within this period. The prohibitions will only be operative when indicated on site by the presence of the appropriate traffic signs in accordance with The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures will be locally signed.
5. Pedestrian access to premises on or adjacent to the road will not be prohibited by any provision of this order.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow surface dressing works to be carried out.
