(SMALDEN LANE, GRINDLETON, RIBBLE VALLEY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Smalden Lane, Grindleton, from the junction of High Cliff Greaves Road to the junction of Grindleton Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022 until 1700 hours on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2022 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-  
Barrett Hill Brow – Holden Lane – Bolton by Bowland Road – Smalden Lane – Sawley Road – Main Street – High Cliff Greaves and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Carriageway Resurfacing works to be carried out.
