A Senior Designated Key Worker has been recruited, who will be joining the team in July.

Interviews are taking place at the end of May for the remaining two Senior Designated Key Workers and one Administrator post. It is hoped this will result in a full team by the end of the summer.

The national evaluation will include all the "Early Adopter" site but not the "pilot" sites. As we are a pilot site we will not be included in the national evaluation and need to do our own evaluation.

A working group will outline a scope for our evaluation and bring it to the next steering group for discussion.
