(BRECK ROAD, POULTON LE FYLDE, WYRE BOROUGH)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Breck Road, Poulton le Fylde in a **southerly** direction from its junction with Skippool Roundabout for approximately 100 metres in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Monday 25th July 2022 until 2359 hours on Thursday 1st September 2022 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Junction at Breck Rd and Skippool Roundabout - Amounderness Way (West) - Norcross roundabout - B5268 Fleetwood Road South (South Direction) - B5267 Poulton Road (East Direction) - Tithebarn Street - Queensway B5267 (South Direction) - Blackpool Old Road (East Direction) - Queens Square (East Direction) - Breck Rd A588 (North Direction) - Head North on A588 Breck Road

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow construction works associated with the A585 Windy Harbour Project to be carried out by National Highways.
