

Notes about the resources

These consist of present continuous forms for 10 of the 40 most common verbs in English, as well as pronouns and forms of the verb 'to be'. They include gap fill sentence versions of 10 given images (see verbs -matching activity).

Possible activities -

- 1) Cut out the verb images and verb spellings and match them;
- 2) Complete gap fill sentences in the present progressive;
- 3) Students can simply say sentences about what is happening in the images;
- 4) The complete sentences can be cut up so that students have to rearrange them;
- 5) Students can write sentences about what is happening in the images.
