

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Activities

- Cut out the pictures. Shuffle them, make a pile, face down. Turn over the pictures and say a sentence about the picture containing the correct pronoun, eg 'He has a pink hat.'
- 2. Play 'Go fish' with a partner. (You will need two sets of the pictures). Shuffle the cards. Deal three to each player. The rest go in a pile face down. Make sets of three by asking, 'Do you have a he/they/she/it picture?' If they have one, they have to give it to you. If not, they say 'Go fish' and you get one from the pile. Person who gets rid of all their cards is the winner, or person with least cards when the pile is used up is the winner.
- 3. You will need a set of picture cards and a set of pronoun cards. The picture cards should be spread out as targets. They can be spread out on the floor or a table. You can use a small ball or screwed up piece of paper or even a paper clip to toss onto the target. Pronoun cards are face down. Turn one over and you have to hit the correct target.
