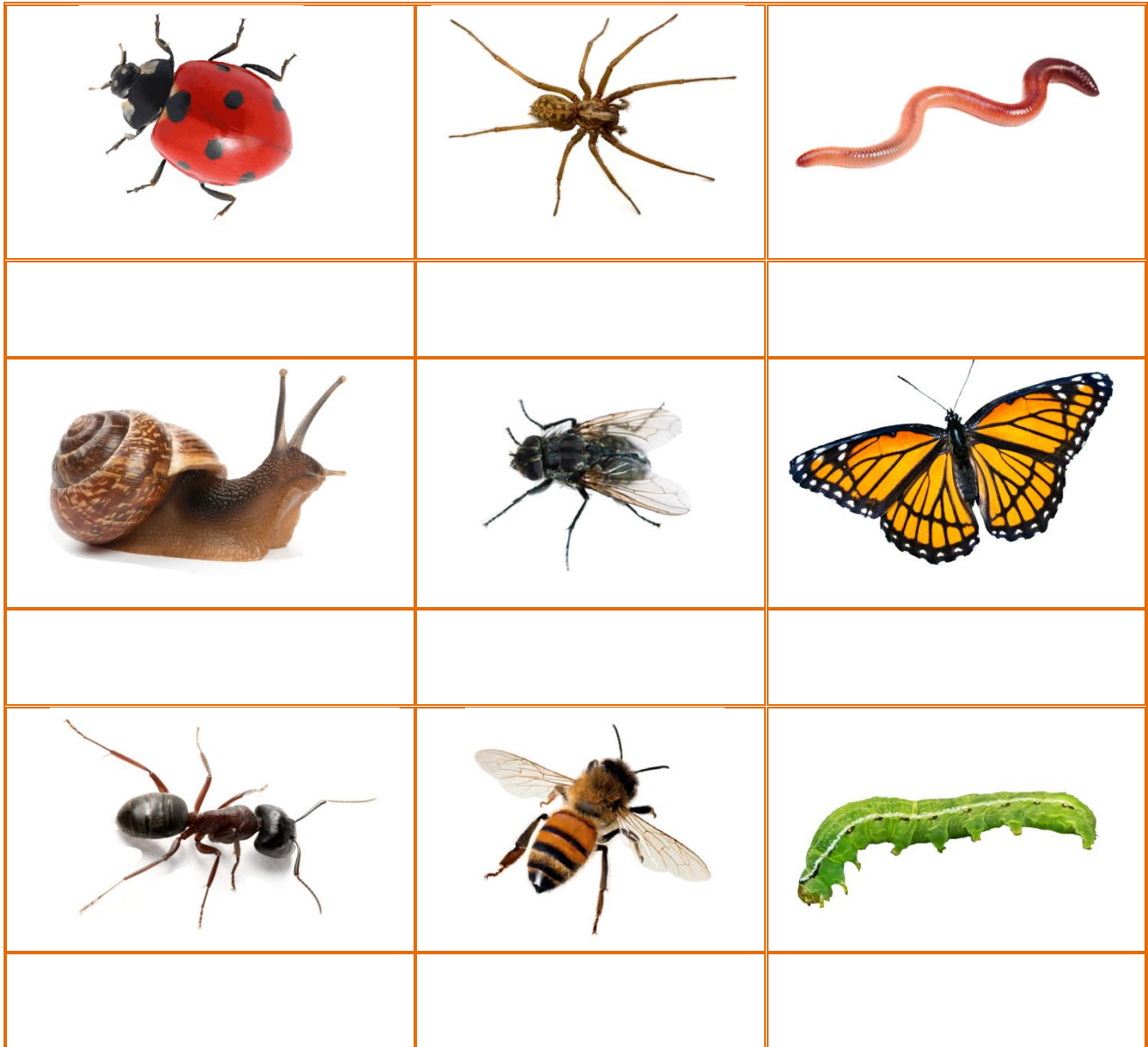

 Honey Bee	<p>A honey bee has 6 legs and 4 wings. It is brown with orange stripes. It has antennae. Its body is about 20 mm long. It eats nectar from flowers.</p>
 House Spider	<p>A house spider is brown and has 8 legs. Its body is about 15 mm long. It does not have antennae. It makes silk for its web and traps its prey. It eats small insects.</p>
 Earthworm	<p>An earthworm has no legs. Its body is reddish-brown and it is made of lots of segments. It can be up to 300 mm long. It lives in the ground and eats soil which then goes back into the earth.</p>
 7-spot ladybird	<p>7-spot ladybird has 6 legs and 4 wings. It has antennae. Its body is red with black spots and it is up to 8 mm long. It eats aphids such as greenfly.</p>

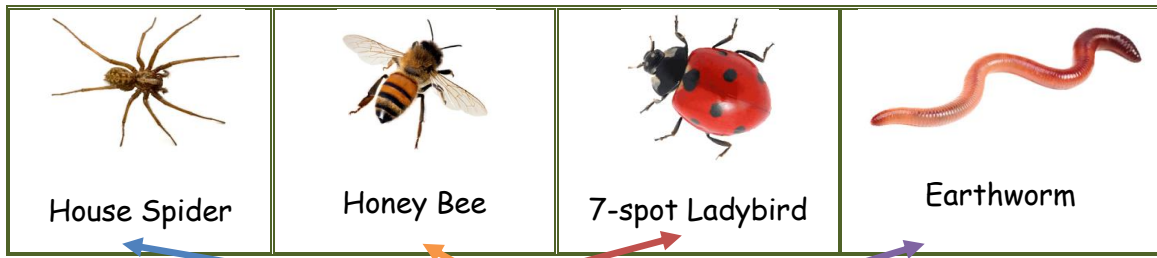
