




Properties of materials

hard

not easily broken or bent; solid, firm.





soft

easy to fold, mould or cut.



rough

the surface of an object is uneven, irregular



the surface of an object is even or regular with no lumps









opaque not letting light through





transparent

allowing light to pass through





dull

lacking brightness or sheen



chopping board



shiny reflecting light



pots



stiff

not easily bent or changed in shape



able to stretch easily









absorbent

able to soak up liquid

not absorbent

not capable of absorbing or soaking up (liquids)









having hardness but easily damaged

brittle



post box



flower pots

flexible

capable of bending easily without breaking



banknotes



waterproof

repels water and liquids

not waterproof

lets water pass through it



reusable shopping bag
