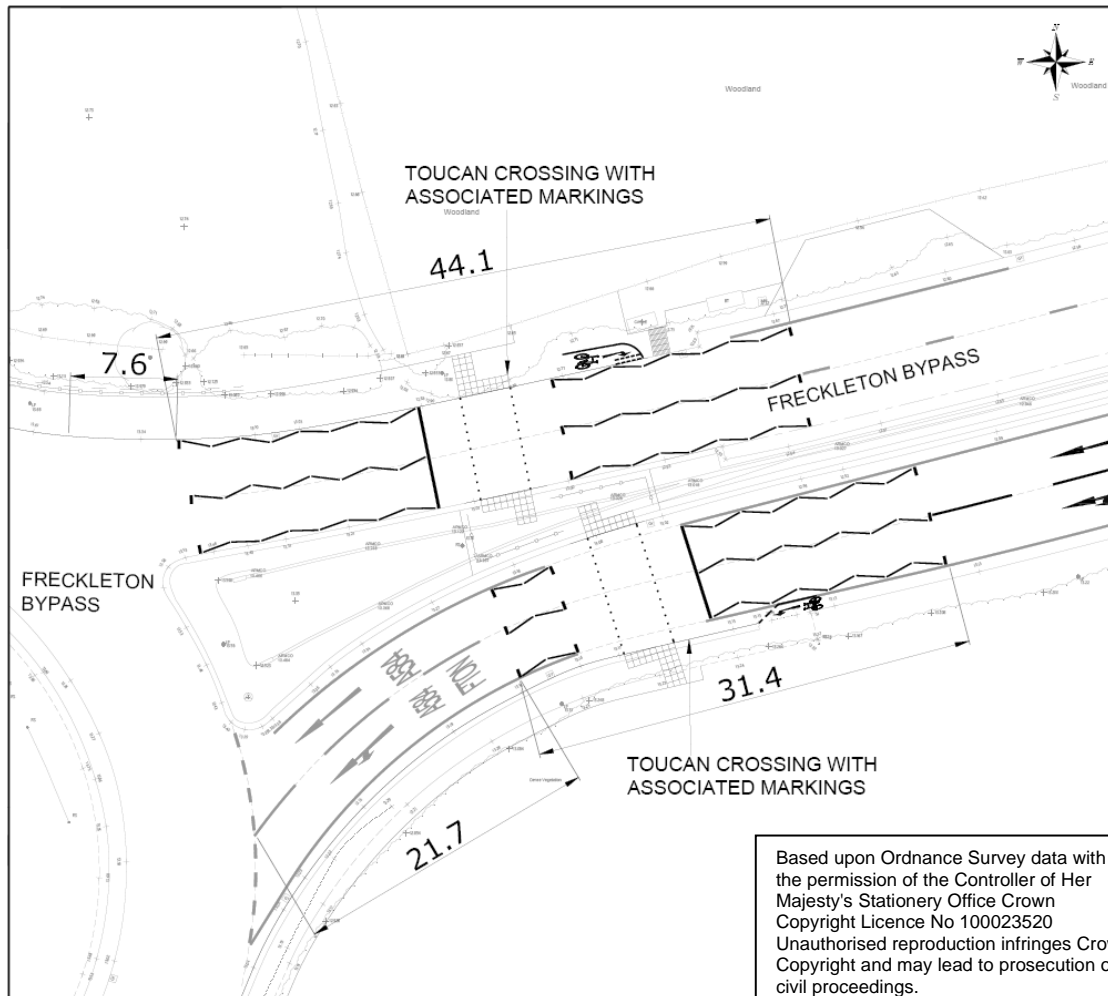


NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(A584 FRECKLETON BYPASS, WARTON, FYLDE
BOROUGH) (PEDESTRIAN CROSSING)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above pedestrian crossing under Section 23 of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a toucan crossing in the following locations:

- a) A584 Freckleton Bypass, Warton, the north east bound carriageway, from a point 7.6 metres east of its roundabout junction for a distance of 44.1 metres in an easterly direction;
- b) A584 Freckleton Bypass, Warton, the south west bound carriageway, from a point 21.7 metres east of its junction with its roundabout junction for a distance of 31.4 metres in an easterly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The proposal is designed to provide a safe crossing point for cyclists and pedestrians using the shared cycle/footway along the A584 Freckleton Bypass which forms part of the county principal road network. These proposals are being funded by Section 278 monies deposited by developer and linked to the adjacent development site as part of a planning condition/ requirement.
