**KINROSS STREET AND AIRDRIE CRESCENT, BURNLEY BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Burnley Borough:-
 - a. Kinross Street from its junction with Melrose Avenue to its junction with Airdrie Crescent.
 - b. Airdrie Crescent in a northerly direction only from its junction with Kinross Street to its junction with Melrose Avenue.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 5th September 2022 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 5th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Motor vehicles travelling in a Southerly direction on Airdrie Crescent will be unaffected.**
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is;

Kinross Street – Airdrie Crescent – Melrose Avenue – Harold Street.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new housing development works to be carried out.
