(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Tenterfield Street, Preston from Lawson Street to Lancaster Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 9th January 2023 until 0900 hours on Wednesday 30th October 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic is not available at this location.

And Further – Hoarding will be erected along the footpath of Ring Way from a point at the side of Lime House to a point at the side of Ribchester House, access will be maintained for pedestrians.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Eric Wright Construction Ltd to carry out the construction of the new Animate project on the site of the old mark.
