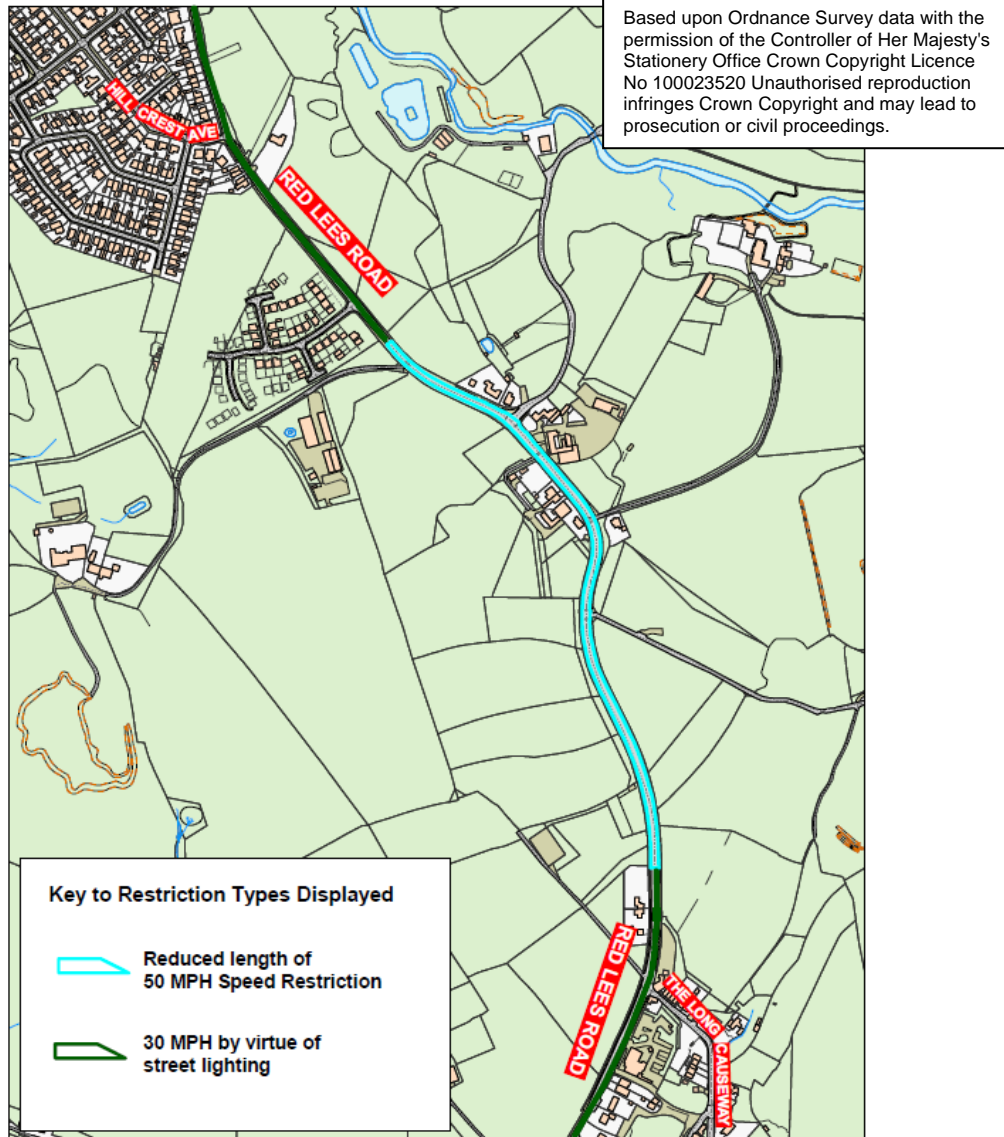


NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(RED LEES ROAD, CLIVIGER, BURNLEY BOROUGH) (REVOCATION
AND 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 83(2) and 84 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 22 April 2022 and 20 May 2022, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

Remove the length from the Schedule and replace with the below:

Red Lees Road, Cliviger, from a point 320 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Hill Crest Avenue, to a point 146 metres north of its junction with the centreline of The Long Causeway.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of the modification is to amend the description of the 50 mph at the southern end due to an administrative error on the original proposals.

The modification amends the description to match the placement of the existing speed limit terminals on site, which Officer's confirm are placed in the correct location.
