Concerns were raised by residents regarding parked vehicles causing an obstruction around the junction of Manor Lane and Cop Lane.

Site visits carried out on different days and at different times of the day confirmed the concerns that had been raised as a number of vehicles were parked in this location close to the junction.

To address the issue, the County Council is proposing to introduce a No Waiting At Any Time restriction to remove the obstructive parking and assist with the general movement of traffic along the roads and at the junction with Manor Lane and Cop Lane.
