

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CHIPPING LANE AND INGLEWHITE ROAD, LONGRIDGE, RIBBLE
VALLEY BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Chipping Lane, Longridge, the north west side, from a point 48.5 metres southwest of its junction with the projected centreline of Primrose Road for a distance of 25 metres in a south westerly direction;
- b) Chipping Lane, Longridge, the south east side, from a point 44 metres southwest of its junction with the centreline of Primrose Road for a distance of 35 metres in a south westerly direction;
- c) Inglewhite Road, Longridge, the west side, from a point 21 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Barnacre Road for a distance of 37 metres in a southerly direction;
- d) Inglewhite Road, Longridge, the east side, from a point 18.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Isabella Street for a distance of 17 metres in a northerly direction.
