LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A586 GARSTANG ROAD, SINGLETON, FYLDE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTION) NOTICE 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council considers it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily restrict traffic to 30mph on the said roads set out below in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to exceed the speed of 30mph over the following lengths of highway:
 - i. A586 Garstang Road, Singleton from its merging with A586 Garstang Road East for a distance of 917 metres in an easterly direction.
- The prohibition will be operative from 1220 hours on Friday 26th May 2023 until 2359 hours on Tuesday 30th May 2023 or until completion of the works within this period.

No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow major highway redevelopment works in connection with the A585 Windy Harbour scheme to be safely carried out.
