

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(A586 GARSTANG ROAD, SINGLETON, FYLDE BOROUGH)  
(TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTION) ORDER 2023**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** Lancashire County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the County Council”) being the Traffic Authority for various roads in the Borough of Fylde, has made an Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that traffic on the said roads set out below should be restricted to 30mph by reason of facilitating major highway redevelopment works.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to exceed the speed of 30mph over the following lengths of highway:
  - i. A586 Garstang Road, Singleton from its merging with A586 Garstang Road East for a distance of 917 metres in an easterly direction.
2. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on **Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2023** until **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024** or until the completion of works within this period.

No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

The Police, Fire and Ambulance Services have been informed.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the continuation of major highway redevelopment works in connection with the A585 Windy Harbour scheme to be safely carried out.
